Implements Engagement and Partnerships

Team Decision Making that encourage inter-agency collaboration: A strategy and practice to keep families involved and for public child welfare agencies to invite families and others to actively participate in agency decisions about their children.
Mentorship programs: Innovatively implemented for special populations such as youth at risk of incarceration or entering into the judicial systems.

Bridge Foundation uses field-tested family support curriculum which has been applied internationally in early childhood and school settings across the country. The curriculum is focused on building strong relationships with families and is used for professional development for educators and service providers. Bridge Foundation also encourages related strategies such as functional family therapy interventions.
